


Figure 1: Lifetime Use of Smokeless Tobacco




Figure 2: Lifetime Use of Cigarettes




Figure 3: Lifetime Use of Alcohol




Figure 4: Lifetime Use of Inhalants




Figure 5: Lifetime Use of Cocaine




Figure 6: Lifetime Use of Marijuana




Figure 7: Lifetime Use of Heroin




Figure 8: Lifetime Use of Hallucinogens




Figure 9: Lifetime Use of Ecstasy




Figure 10: Lifetime Use of Methamphetamines




Figure 11: Lifetime Use of Prescription Pain Relievers (Vicodin, Oxycontin, ...)

#### Lifetime Use of Prescription Tranquilizers (Xanax, Valium, ...)




Figure 12: Lifetime Use of Prescription Tranquilizers (Xanax, Valium, ...)




Figure 13: Lifetime Use of Prescription Stimulants (Ritalin, Adderall, ...)




Figure 14: Past 30 Day Use of Smokeless Tobacco




Figure 15: Past 30 Day Use of Cigarettes




Figure 16: Past 30 Day Use of Alcohol




Figure 17: Past 30 Day Use of Inhalants




Figure 18: Past 30 Day Use of Cocaine




Figure 19: Past 30 Day Use of Marijuana




Figure 20: Past 30 Day Use of Heroin




Figure 21: Past 30 Day Use of Hallucinogens




Figure 22: Past 30 Day Use of Ecstasy





Figure 23: Past 30 Day Use of Methamphetamines




Figure 25: Past 30 Day Use of Prescription Tranquilizers (Xanax, Valium, ...)




Figure 26: Past 30 Day Use of Prescription Stimulants (Ritalin, Adderall, ...)

#### 2 Perceived Risk of Use




Figure 27: Smoke One or More Packs of Cigarettes per Day




Figure 28: Take 1 or 2 Drinks of an Alcoholic Beverage Nearly Every Day




Figure 29: Try Marijuana Once or Twice




Figure 30: Smoke Marijuana Regularly




Figure 31: Perception of Parental Disapproval of Smoking Cigarettes




Figure 32: Perception of Parental Disapproval of Drinking Alcohol




Figure 33: Perception of Parental Disapproval of Smoking Marijuana




Figure 34: Avg Age of First Use for Smoked a Cigarette

#### Avg Age of First Use for Drank Alcohol




Figure 35: Avg Age of First Use for Drank Alcohol

#### Avg Age of First Use for Drank Alcohol Regularly (1-2 Times/Month)




Figure 36: Avg Age of First Use for Drank Alcohol Regularly (1-2 Times/Month)




Figure 37: Avg Age of First Use for Smoked Marijuana




Figure 38: Community Opportunities for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 39: Community Rewards for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 40: Family Attachment




Figure 41: Family Opportunities for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 42: Family Rewards for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 43: School Opportunities for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 44: School Rewards for Prosocial Involvement




Figure 45: Religiosity

## Social Skills Protective Factor - Peer-Individual Domain




Figure 46: Social Skills




Figure 47: Belief in the Moral Order




Figure 48: Low Neighborhood Attachment




Figure 49: Community Disorganization




Figure 50: Community Transitions and Mobility




Figure 51: Laws and Norms Favorable to Drug Use and Firearms




Figure 52: Perceived Availability of Drugs and Firearms




Figure 53: Poor Family Supervision




Figure 54: Poor Family Discipline




Figure 55: Family History of Antisocial Behavior




Figure 56: Parental Attitudes Favorable Toward ATOD Use




Figure 57: Parental Attitudes Favorable Toward Antisocial Behavior




Figure 58: Academic Failure




Figure 59: Low Commitment to School




Figure 60: Rebelliousness




Figure 61: Friends Delinquent Behavior




Figure 62: Friends Use of Drugs




Figure 63: Peer Rewards for Antisocial Behavior




Figure 64: Favorable Attitudes toward Antisocial Behavior




Figure 65: Favorable Attitudes Toward Drug Use




Figure 66: Early Initiation of Drug Use and Antisocial Behavior




Figure 67: Sensation Seeking




Figure 68: Gang Involvement
