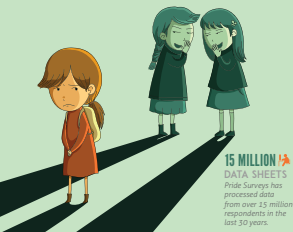
THE SOCIAL, EMOTIONAL AND BULLYING BEHAVIOR SURVEY (SEBBS)

The SEBBS assesses middle school students' bullying perceptions and problem behaviors that affect student engagement.

THE COMMUNITIES THAT CARE SURVEY (CTC YOUTH SURVEY)

Sites that previously administered the CTC Youth Survey can continue to collect data using our replica to measure:

- Social and emotional skills
- Peer relations
- Bullying behaviors
- School climate
- Substance abuse

7.7 MILLION RESPONDENTS The Pride Questionnaire for Grades 6-12 is our longest-running and most utilized survey to date, with more than 7.7 million respondents since 1982.

SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEYS

THE PRIDE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT SURVEY (LES)

The LES measures:

- School climate
- Student/teacher relationships at school
- Students and learning
- Teacher involvement
- Students at home and in the community
- Student alcohol, tobacco and other drug use
- Student mental health
- Other student behaviors such as: violence, bullying, absenteeism and suspension

PARENT ENGAGEMENT AND PERCEPTION SURVEY

We also offer surveys that allow parents to get involved. The Parent Engagement and Perception Questionnaire can be tied to the Pride TES and LES to gather a 360-degree view of the perceptions surrounding the school.



A team of 13 top educators, psychologists and survey researchers guided development of the Pride TES and LES during a three-year process.



FACULTY AND STAFF QUESTIONNAIRE

This survey of teachers and other vital school personnel measures:

- Perception of student drug use
- Perception of school safety
- Training needs



- Perception of parental involvement with student behaviors
- Knowledge of school policy related to drug use & violence



THE PRIDE TEACHING ENVIRONMENT SURVEY (TES)

The TES measures:

- Career and intentions
- School Leadership
- Shared Decision Making
- School Climate
- Students and Learning
- The Teaching Experience

The teacher surveys have undergone more than three years of psychometric testing of responses drawn from 72,000 teachers.
